

Annual Town Meeting Bylaw
Town of Tolland, Massachusetts

The annual town meeting and election of town officers shall be held, after seven days notice, anytime during the months of April May or June, and other meetings may be held at such times as the Selectmen may order.

Meetings may be adjourned from time to time to any place within the town. If the day set for the town meeting by by-law or otherwise falls on a legal holiday, such meeting shall be held in the next day following which is not a legal holiday.

The term of office of any elected incumbent town officer shall be for the term for which he was elected and until his successor is elected and qualified.
