## Mandatory Recycling Bylaw Town of Tolland, Massachusetts

In order to implement a program of recycling in conjunction with ordinary waste disposal, residents of every household shall separate waste material into the following categories before depositing same for disposal:

- 1. Glass
- 2. Cans
- 3. Paper
- 4. Cardboard
- 5. Other Wastes

If no separation takes place, waste material shall not be accepted at the disposal location.

The recycling of paper and cardboard shall become mandatory immediately and the recycling of other items shall become in force upon the direction of the Board of Health.

**Penalty for Violation of this Bylaw:** In addition to any other legal remedies that may be available, Whoever violates any provision of this by-law, the violation of which is subject to specific penalty, may be penalized by non-criminal disposition as provided in Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 40, Section 21D as amended in accordance with the penalty and fine schedule established in the Town of Tolland Bylaw.
