Commercial Vehicles Posting Bond Bylaw Town of Tolland, Massachusetts

No vehicle used for commercial purposes may enter upon the town ways from a roadside shoulder without first posting a bond, either cash or surety, for the repair of any damage caused thereby. The Superintendent of highways shall determine the amount of the bond to be posted.

This provision shall not apply to vehicles with a gross loaded weight of less than 10,000 pounds.

Penalty for Violation of this Bylaw: In addition to any other legal remedies that may be available, Whoever violates any provision of this by-law, the violation of which is subject to specific penalty, may be penalized by non-criminal disposition as provided in Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 40, Section 21D as amended in accordance with the penalty and fine schedule established in the Town of Tolland Bylaw.
